## Approval of Minutes

## Dr. Sidell reported, Elementary Principal Update:

- Halloween Parade went well yesterday.
- Teachers and Admin went to writing workshop. MA and nationally, moving to a tiered model system.
- New reading benchmark assessment. Will meet as grade levels and will discuss how will impact teaching.
- Dr. Sidell accompanied $5^{\text {th }}$ grade Field Trip to see where will release turtles. Very hands-on experience in Concord in Great Meadow. Will return in the spring. Great teaching points.
- STEM up and running. New Class Math Olympiad. Parent and teacher are corunning it with 22 kids. Will have 2 competitive teams.
- Class Buddies: $5^{\text {th }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade and will also try to match with $8^{\text {th }}$ or $7^{\text {th }}$ grade.
- Dr. Sidell will start a principal BLOG - Start Feb. and also include teacher involvement. Blog content will be around student activities to show parents what teachers are doing. Hopes parents will see value in allowing photos of children at school to be included.
- Talking with teachers and staff: Pre-K through $4^{\text {th }}$ grade is the elementary school. Took an Elementary School Faculty Photograph. Working to give children opportunities to have a sense they are part of the Elementary School. Brainstorming ideas and open to suggestions. Will replace "leadership assemblies" and will reorient toward Elementary assemblies.
- As a group, we discussed possible ideas: talent show, bingo night, elementary math games night. Suggestion to build on existing activities instead of creating a new activity. Identified that there are not as many arts/theater opportunities for children in lower grades. Suggestion to talk to elementary music teacher. Rebecca Besthoff will take the ideas to Dr. Sidell.
