Administration Updates

Dennet Sidell - Thank you for hosting the Newcomers coffee and the staff luncheon. We had a Safety talk with Chief Fisher during the all school assembly. The assembly also included a teacher dance off, where students got to pick dance moves and teach them to the teachers.

Olweus was introduced and thought bubbles were done by all students, telling about a time when someone did something nice for them. During the Elementary assembly, all new staff members where introduced and the four rules of Olweus and the steps to courage. Kids got a card that have the rules on one side and the steps to courage on the other. All staff have the same language so they can address any incident that they view no matter the grade. Minimum of 2 times a week the teachers are talking about the Olweus program during class. Great turn out for Elementary parents night. Talked about Dot Day and how we are reaching out to kids from other states and nations using Skype. Parent training for Olweus will be coming in the fall.

Middle school - Back to School night will start at 530 this Thursday Oct 5. Register for iParent through the school website, this will allow parents to look at progress reports and report cards online.

Jim O'Shea - Working on budget planning and looking at our needs internally. Our student projection was 25 under this year. In working on our objectives for the next 3 to 5 years we originally had fours objectives - rich curriculum, creating an inclusive community, ensure equity and excellence in learning, and provide continued professional development for our staff. After input from the School Committee, we have decided to focus on the first three goals with opportunities for staff development rolled into each. The school budget will be drafted in front of the school board next Wednesday. We will work to build in flexibility to the budget to allow for unexpected projections. Our goal is to make sure we have the finances in place to continue to provide a quality education.
